

Viburnum plicatum

(Japanese Snowball Bush)

Show- ball bush is a multi stemmed deciduous medium-sized shrub reaching 2.5-3 m in height. The horizontal branching gives a layered appearance. The branching pattern adds character that lasts throughout all four seasons in the garden. It has a deciduous leaves which turned red/ purple in the fall. The flowers form a large flat-topped cyme. The outside flowers are sterile and surrounding the fertile flowers. The fruit is an egg-shaped drupe attracts birds in the winter time. it is used an a mass planation or in shrub borders. This species has two natural forms form plicatum and form tomentosum which is called the doublefile viburnum.
