Bearberry cotoneaster is an evergreen shrub native to central China. It has small glossy leaves. In late spring, it has numerous tiny white flowers, replaced by red berries in fall. In winter, the leaves take on a purplish hue. It tolerates many soil types and full or partial sun. It should be pruned back every few years.
