# Hypericum calycinum

## (Aaron's Beard or St. Johnswort)

A stoloniferous subshrub or shrublet, typically growing 0.5—1 m therefore could be planted as a ground cover. Features large, rose-like, yellow flowers having numerous, bushy stamens with reddish anthers. Flowers appear in summer. Oval to oblong, distinctively net-veined (from beneath) leaves are rich green in sun but are a lighter, yellowish green in shade. Deciduous in cold regions but becomes evergreen under warm climate. Plants of the genus Hypericum (some species have been used since ancient times in the treatment of wounds) were apparently gathered and burned to ward off evil spirits on the eve of St. John's Day, thus giving rise to the genus common name of St. John's wort. Easily grown in average, medium, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Tolerates wide range of soils. Thrives on sandy soils in full sun. Spreads rapidly by underground stems and can spread aggressively in ideal growing conditions. Used as a ground cover.
