(Woadwaxen)

Lydia Broom is an open multi-stemmed deciduous (evergreen in warm climate) shrub with a ground-hugging habit of growth . Lydia Broom features showy yellow pea-like flowers along the branches from mid to late spring. It has light green foliage throughout the season. The small oval leaves do not develop any appreciable fall colour. The lime green stems can be quite attractive. It will grow maximum of 80 cm with a 1.5 m spread. It grows at a slow rate, and under ideal conditions can be expected to live for approximately 20 years. Could be used as a mass plantation, ground cover, very urban tolerant. This is a relatively low maintenance shrub, and should only be pruned after flowering to avoid removing any of the current season's flowers This shrub should only be grown in full sunlight. It prefers dry to average moisture levels with very well-drained soil, and will die in standing water. It is considered to be drought-tolerant, and thus makes an ideal choice for a low-water garden or xeriscape application. It is particular about its soil conditions, with a strong preference for sandy, alkaline soils, and is able to handle environmental salt.
