Metrosideros collina

(New Zealand Christmas tree, Pohutukawa tree)

Pohutukawaw is native to New Zealand, it blooms there in December, which is summertime in the southern hemisphere. This broadleaf evergreen tree develops an upright, rounded canopy. Young plants resemble shrubs but develop into trees with age. They are covered with glossy green, oval leaves with recurved edges. As plants age, the leathery leaves become less shiny and turn dark green with gray, felty undersides.. Anytime from spring to early summer a cluster of crimson flowers appear that lack petals but are teeming with long, whisker-like stamens. Emerging buds are white and felty. Nectar-loving insects and birds relish the blossoms and leathery seed capsules develop after pollinated. Grow the plant in a sunny spot with loam that is slightly acidic. This plant tolerates heat, drought and salt spray, and can tolerate minor frost. Lower branches can be pruned away to encourage a tree-like habit. It makes a fine tree for mild coastal landscapes. Plant as a specimen tree in a, seaside garden, or large planter. It has many surface roots that can damage pavement, so it does not make a good street tree for space-limited tree lawns.
