An upright shrub with a spreading habit. Its a deciduous shrub that prefers acidic soil and tolerates drought. It has a green leaves that turn yellow and red in the fall while in the winter its bare branches and yellow flowers. Its bark is smooth and sandy brown gray. Its flowers have 4 wrinkled petals that have a strong sweet scent
