Kalanchoe blossfediana is a tender perennial that has an evergreen foliage, and blooms in late winter and early spring. It has thick, oval-shaped leaves. The showy flowers can vary in color, from red, orange, pink and yellow.

Usually grown in containers and makes a great house plant. Flowering Kalanchoe is drought resistant, and usually susceptible of root rot, so to be watered only when needed.
