Used mainly as a hedge as it take trimming very well, but also nice as a screen or a foundational plant. Prune after flowering. Plant common privet with caution, it is considered an invasive exotic plant in parts of the United States and prohibited by some entities. All parts of plant are poisonous if ingested
