

Wodyetia bifurcata

(Foxtail palm)

The foxtail palm has one of the most spectacular foliage displays of all palms. Single trunk palm, delicately arched long leaves. The leaves look like a foxtail or bottle brush and swing from the smallest wind. The crownshaft is longer than most other palms. Reaching about 9 m it becomes perfect as a patio, terrace or specimen plantation. It grows best in full sun and tolerates wide variety of soils. It is considered as drought tolerant plant and only little frost it can tolerate.
