Cotinus coggygia 'Flame' is a slow growing plant. It is an open crowned, rounded small tree. It has pinkish-red-colored flowers that come out in spring and early summer give the effect of a cloud of dark pink smoke. The soil's pH doesn't affect the plant, for it to survive needs moderate amount of water, full to partial sunlight. It is known for its fall color which is an excellent orange-red.
