# Schefflera arboricola

# (Dwarf Schefflera)

Hawaiian or dwarf schefflera is a medium to large evergreen shrub. The glossy green leaves are hand-shaped (palmate) with seven to eleven leaflets. The leaves are waxy, succulent and green when new, becoming tan and semiwoody when old. If the leaves or stems are crushed or cut, a pungent fragrance of fresh black pepper is released. The flower and the fruit do not have any landscape importance. The plant is often used as a landscape shrub in warm, frost-free areas and as an interior plant in cooler zones. Outside, it prefers humid environments, partial sun to part shade and fertile, well-drained soil. It is moderately drought tolerant once established. It can be used as a hedge, specimen planting,or a poolside container plant. It also trains well into an espalier on the wall of a building. All parts of plant are poisonous if ingested
