Forsythia x intermedia

(Border Forsithia)

An upright or spreading deciduous fast growing shrub. Leaves have toothed margins, ovate shape without any fall coloring. Flowers appear early spring (March-April) on the last year branches. It has a brilliant yellow color lasting 2-3 weeks. Fruit has no landscape interest. The plant adapts to many soils. Tolerant of shade but best grown on partial sun or shade. Occasional rejuvenation (heavy) pruning refreshes the plant. Used as border, mass plantation, screening. The plant has urban tolerance allowing us to plant them in cities.
