

Jatropha podagrica

(Buddha Belly Plant, Bottleplant Shrub)

Rarely found succulent plant with 1-1.5 m height. Swollen trunk and huge lobed leaves and brilliant scarlet coral like flowers. The flowers are are long-lasting, you will see them almost year round. Jatropha plant parts can be toxic, especially seeds. Keep your eye on small kids and don't let them play with Jatropha seeds
