## (Red fescue)

Red fescue is found in many natural green areas on nearly all types of soils and under widely varying moisture conditions. Red fescue is relatively slow growing in the sowing year, and has very fine leaves and high shoot density. It thrives under a wide range of conditions, but is noted for its tolerance to dry poor soil. It is very resistant to frost and drought, and it tolerates some surface water during the winter. It has excellent shade tolerance.
