

Coreopsis grandiflora

(largeflower tickseed)

Easily grown in a dry area with well-drained soil in full sun. Thrives in poor, sandy or rocky soils. Tolerant of heat, humidity, and drought. In late spring to early summer its covered with many single golden flowers. The blooms attract butterflies and will continue blooming if deadheaded regularly.

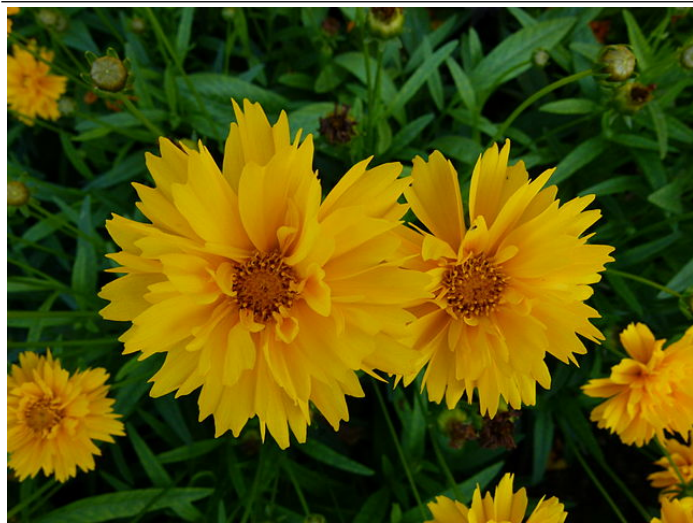
