

Hamamelis x intermedia 'diane'

(Diane Showy Witchhazel, Showy Witchhazel)

A red flowered winter-blooming shrub with dark green leaves that are lighter on the lower side and slightly fuzzy. Much like the other Hamamelis intermedia it prefers full sun and organic soil that is moist and tolerates drought. Its flowers have both a sweet and spicy scent and a bark that is smooth and brownish gray, the twigs that carry the flowers are lighter in color even whitish gray.
